

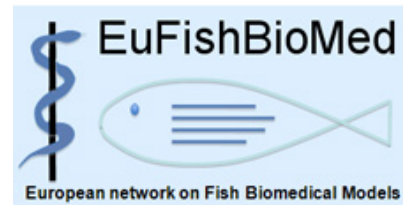

EuFishBioMed grants

GUIDELINES, EZPM Trento

Overview

The EuFishBioMed grants, short term fellowships or travel grants, are designed to provide financial support for early career researchers

- or to visit conferences about fish research (travel grants).

3 grants will be awarded in total. (500€ each)

The aim is to enhance and strengthen links for future collaboration and enhance the researcher's career opportunities. The call is open to all researchers meeting the requirements listed below.

1. Who can participate?

- **Early Career Researcher**
We would expect early career researchers to have been awarded their PhD not more than 2 years prior to applying for the Travel Grant, but allowances can be made for career breaks or other extenuating circumstances.
- **Please note: EZPM in Trento is a PI meeting.**

Only one application may be submitted per researcher. Duplicate applications will not be eligible, even if they are to different countries.

- **Being a member of the EuFishBioMed e.V. Society**
The group leader must be a member of the EuFishBioMed society, and they must have a research or academic post (permanent or fixed-term) or fellowship (excluding visiting or honorary fellowship) at a recognised publicly funded research establishment, or public or private Higher Education Institution. The researchers can be of any nationality, but they must be able to secure a visa for the country which they plan to visit.
The name of the EuFishBioMed member must be stated in your application (see: grant application form). New members: payment and membership form has to be finished by the deadline of the announcement.

2. Purpose of research visit

- Participation at the EZPM, 2018 (Trento)

3. Funding

3.1 The funding for each grant is set at 500 €, but applicants can request more, if required. The final value of the award will be stipulated in the award letter. The EuFishBioMed society will not increase the value of an award at a later stage.

3.2 The award is a contribution to cover costs relating to travel, accommodation, subsistence, visas, and insurance.

- 3.3 The award holder must comply with ALL of the following conditions. They must:
- a) Use the award only for costs relating to travel, accommodation and subsistence. Researchers must make all their own travel and accommodation arrangements, including visas and insurance.
 - b) Accept full responsibility for all aspects of the visit and take out insurance for any risks associated with taking part in travelling abroad, including all unexpected and uncontrollable events. The EuFishBioMed society will not be liable for the consequences of any such risks or any costs incurred.
 - c) Reimbursement of your expenses:
Submit a copy of the receipts, a summary of the costs and a claim for travel expenses by your home institution back to EuFishBioMed Office with complete details and original signature, preferably in blue ink, within 60 days of the meeting/ of your lab visit's end date.
